Roland introduced speaker Carol TeBockhorst from Make-A-Wish Iowa whose mission is: Together, we create life-changing wishes for children with critical illnesses. There are currently 25 wishes for Scott County in the wish pipeline. A child does not have to be terminally ill to receive a wish; once the child is referred to Wish and qualifies, the wish must be approved by a physician. Children are most often referred to by family or medical team, but anyone can refer a child to Make-A-Wish! Children ages 2 1/2-18 may qualify, and Make-A-Wish will honor the wish up until a child turns 21 and is "aged out." The average cost of a wish in Iowa is \$15,000. Volunteers are very important to Make-A-Wish and are responsible for meeting with the families and presenting the wish to the child. Carol shared a video with the group and everyone was moved to tears. Terry did not fine anyone, and the meeting was closed with the Optimist Creed.
